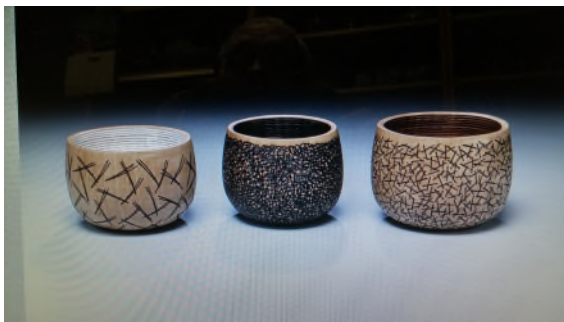
JUNE MEETING

MAY MEETING

DEMONSTRATOR: Dan Douthard

DEMONSTRATION: The subject of Dan's demo was cross-drilled Christmas ornaments. This is a timely demo considering that Marketplace and Christmas ornament exchange is just around the corner! We were joined by five Eagle Ranch students and Eagle Ranch headmaster Jon Dewal to view the demo. The students each brought in some turnings for the instant gallery. They were unable to stay for the entire demo but hopefully they saw how the club meetings are conducted.

Dan began his demo with a pre-cut and pre drilled sample of the main body of the ornament. He then proceeded to drill a blank so that we could see the steps in preparation of the ornament. Cross drilling was performed on the lathe and the 1 ¼ inch holes were cut only half way through to ensure alignment and to reduce tearout.

The finial and icicle were turned to complete the project. The same layout theme was used for both pieces. You can find a detailed demo of this project on Youtube video by Dan by searching Dan Douthard.

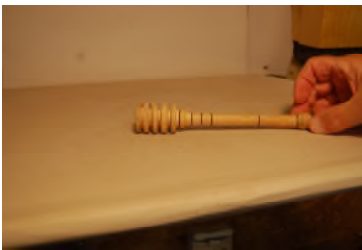
