Demo: Ornaments.

Demonstrator: Jerry Chandler

Jerry is a long time member of Chattahoochee Turners and an outstanding turner. He supports our club 110%. We are very fortunate to have him demonstrate for us in November.

The purpose of this demo is to encourage all of our turners, regardless of experience level, to turn an ornament. The focus will be on turning ornaments that resemble old style Christmas tree light. We'll look at a couple of options for simulating the brass threaded part of the bulb as well as some finishing options. You are also encouraged to bring examples of favorite ornaments you have turned and share your experience with us. Specifically we're looking for simple ornament that would be ease and fulfilling for others to turn.



Christmas Meeting

This year's December Christmas Gathering will be on Tuesday, December 10, 2013. We will start dinner at 6:30 PM so plan on coming around 6:00 PM. We want to get a head start on the fund raising raffle that we usually have each year. Enclosed are ten raffle tickets.
