JUNE DEMONSTRATION

DEMONSTRATOR: Robert Austin

Biography: Rob Austin enjoys almost all forms of woodworking. Growing up he hung around his grandfather's lumber yard and was able to play with wood all day! Having access to a lumberyard worth of wood and tons of nails was great for making his own toys, tool boxes and anything else he wanted. Being in the Air Force for 21 years prevented him from buying any major woodworking tools. Just could not get the government to move thousands of pounds of tools from country to country. After retirement he made up for it by having a 1,800 square foot shop built and filling it full of tools. His shop has 4 lathes, but he will not admit to loving turning more than other forms of woodworking.

Rob has been the vice president of the Gwinnett Woodworking Association (GWA) for 6 years. He loves meeting and working with the other woodworkers. Scheduling 46 meetings a year is a challenge but he says he learns something from each presentation.

As the GWA vice president he has coordinated with other woodworkers to make and donate over 300 wooden walking canes to the Atlanta Veterans Association, 700 plus toys to the Toys-For-Tots program and 2 oak benches for a local hospital waiting room.

Rob lives in Lawrenceville, GA and spends most of his time working in his shop that he calls the Day Care for Adults.

Demonstration: He will use our bandsaw and any hand tools that are required for making adjustments on that brand. Although I don't plan on cutting much if required I will need a vacuum for dust collection. I should have a short video that I made on changing the tires on a band saw but I can present on the available equipment.

Chattahoochee Woodturners Training Scholarship Program

Chattahoochee Woodturners offers financial scholarships to its members based on the following guidelines:

Scholarship Purposes: Scholarships are for hands-on woodturning training from any woodturning instructor or school approved by the board of directors or their appointed committee. Specifically excluded are symposia and non-hands-on demonstrations.

Eligibility: Applicant must have been a member in good standing of Chattahoochee Woodturners for at least twelve (12) consecutive months preceding their request for scholarship, AND must also be a member in good standing of the American Association of Woodturners, AAW. Members who receive a scholarship must wait twelve months from completing their training before applying for another one. Scholarships are not transferrable to anyone else.

Scholarship Amount: The CWT board of directors will determine each year how much money will be allocated to scholarships that year based on assets in the scholarship fund. For 2018, that amount will be \$1,000.00. The maximum scholarship for any one member will be \$250.00 in a twelve month period.

How to Apply: Eligible members may apply by submitting a completed application form to the board Scholarship Chairman (Jerry Chandler) at least sixty (60) days prior to the start date of the instruction. This form must include the following information:

- Name of the CWT member making the request
- Amount requested up to \$250
- What aspect(s) of woodturning will be covered
- Name and contact information of the instructor or school
- Date the training will start and how long it will last
- Goal(s) the member wants to accomplish through this training

The Scholarship Chairman and/or committee will review the application and make a decision within two weeks unless additional information is needed. Their decision will be final.

Payment of Scholarship Funds: The Scholarship Committee will pay the member 80% of the approved scholarship amount at the time the request is approved. The remaining 20% will be paid upon receipt and acceptance of the member's report on the completed training event. If the timing of the event changes, the board must be notified. If the member cancels his/her plans, the money must be returned to the board immediately. A new application may then be made for another training event if the member so chooses.

Report on Completed Training Event: Members attending scholarship training must submit a brief, one page written report of that experience within one month of completion. This report should include the name of the instructor(s), the subject(s), and how the member benefited from the experience. The purpose of this is not only to meet the requirement for receiving the final 20% of the scholarship, but also to assist other members in determining whether this might be a beneficial program for them to consider attending.
